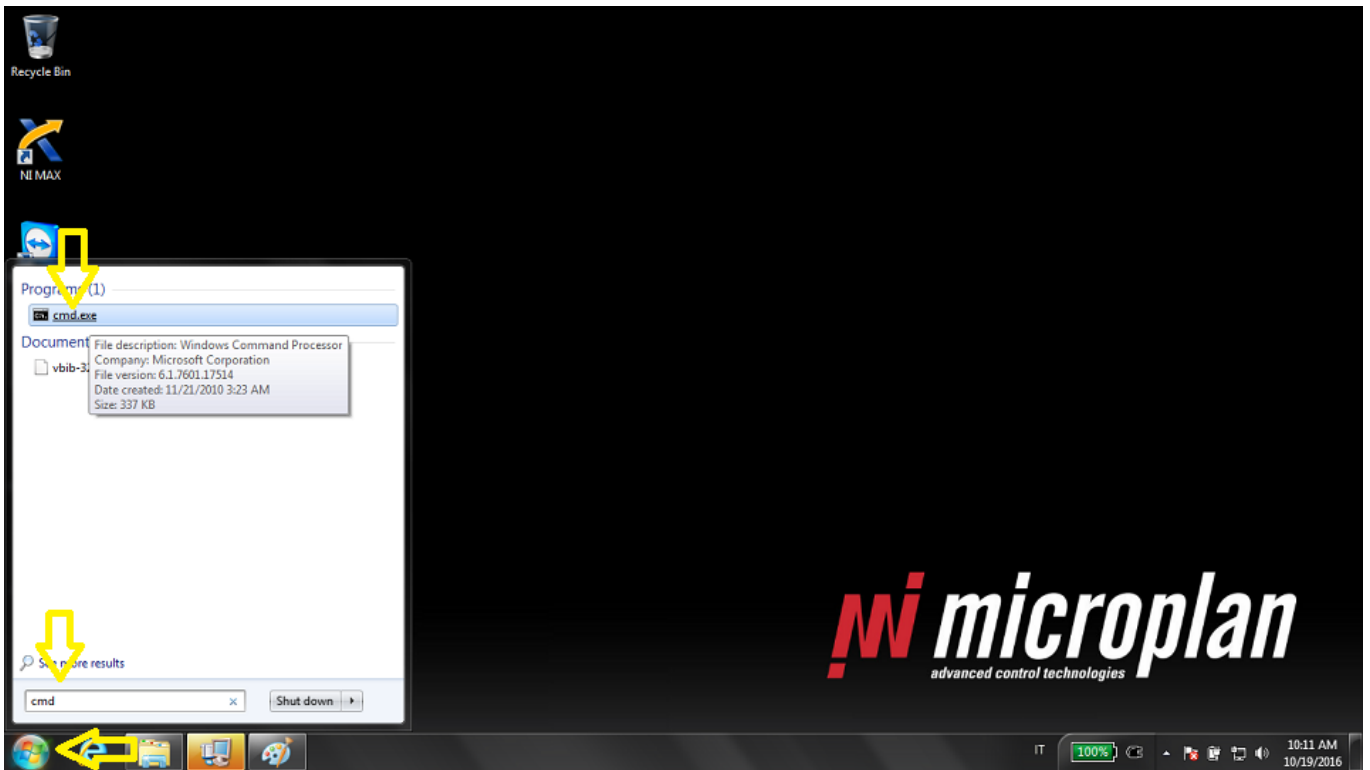




How can I execute a ping?

- Click on Start button (in the bottom left corner)
- Type cmd in the search window
- Click on cmd.exe icon



You will be taken to a black window like the following:





Type the word ping and the address you want to ping, for example ping 192.168.100.101 then press Enter button (see following picture):

```
C:\windows\system32\cmd.exe

If ping is OK you will be returned a series of rows as follows:

```
C:\windows\system32\cmd.exe - ping 192.168.100.101

C:\Users\Test>ping 192.168.100.101

If ping is **NOT OK** you will be returned a different series of rows as follows:

```
C:\windows\system32\cmd.exe
