## What is the difference between Parseq essential and full license?

<u>Parseq</u> offers licenses to match the skill and flexibility level of Microplan's customers. The following table compares the main differences between Technician level access for the **Essential** and **Full** licenses. These features are password protected for limiting access to authorized technicians only.

## Note (1)

This functionality allows the customer to select an existing sequence and copy it, to use it with different values and thresholds. This way the customer can have two different sequences, for different models of boilers for instance. However, this functionality DOES NOT allow the customer to change the structure and the logic of a sequence, for which the Full version of Parseq is required. To prevent proliferation of similar test sequences, that may be difficult to manage, it may be advisable to purchase the Full Parseq license.

The *Essential* license is included with Microplan end-of-line test benches free of charge, while *Full* license has a one-time cost for each PC installation, including those used for development purposes.

Microplan recommends that customers attend proper training by a Microplan specialist to achieve the full benefit of the Parseq *Full license*.

Both the *Full* license and the training course can be purchased separately from the test bench.
